OBJECTIVE OF HEAD COACH, MAPLE LEAFS SEVENS TEAM

The assigned person will perform the role of Head Coach of the Maple Leafs Sevens Team. The role will be viewed as being an integral and significant element of the high performance player pathway process.

The Head Coach, Maple Leafs Sevens Team will lead the team in the events outlined below and will be responsible for developing a successful team environment during the selection, preparation and competition stages.

The Head Coach, Maple Leafs Sevens Team will be a person who has:

- Relevant accreditation requirements to meet the standards of Rugby Canada's coaching pathway.
- High level performance analysis skills;
- A personal Professional Development Plan that incorporates the person's intent to pursue higher level learning and coaching accreditation accompanied by professional development via workshops, clinics, etc.;
- Evidence of recently upgraded accreditation, recent attendance at coaching workshops or evidence of other forms of self education that displays currency as a coach who continues to seek further development;
- Experience at managing assistant coaches and working co-operatively with team managers, strength and conditioning coaches, team medical staff and performance analysis personnel;
- Evidence of understanding of current best practice and a history of performing best practice (preferably recent best practice) as it applies to rugby coaching;
- A thorough knowledge of developments in High Performance Rugby around the world;
- Demonstrated knowledge and understanding of:
 - the structure and dynamics of high performance pathways in Canadian sport;
 - the needs of high performance athletes;
 - the factors that affect Canada's competitiveness internationally; and,
 - trends in international high performance athlete and program management;
- Knowledge of the development plans of Rugby Canada and World Rugby as well as the development protocols of both Rugby Canada and World Rugby;
- Demonstrated evidence of an ability to understand, support and implement development plans;
- A background that displays people management and people leadership skills and attributes;
- Computer literacy especially with spreadsheets, word processing and power point presentations;
- A record of working as a team member, as well as a history of performing in situations that require self-leadership and initiative;
- A background that displays excellent stakeholder relations;
